## FUNDRAISING REQUESTS

The Wildwood Trust are extremely proud to support a wide range of schools and organisations in the local community, where the prime beneficiaries are children, by providing a limited amount of Wildwood entrance tickets as prizes for raffles and fayres. Unfortunately, we do not offer tickets to organisations outside of these categories, or to schools or organisations not local to our parks.

Wildwood is itself a conservation charity dedicated to preserving British wildlife, so we know the importance of effective fundraising.

Please note that all entry tickets will have an expiry date on them of one year from the date of request, so do ensure that your fundraising event and subsequent visit are possible within this timeframe. We are unable to extend or reissue any expired tickets. To send out any fundraising tickets, we will require from you a stamped, self-addressed envelope.

Fundraising requests should be submitted in writing and on headed paper, at least two weeks prior to your event date, to the following address;
